Wednesday, the Fort Wayne African American Cancer Alliance opened the doors to its new office suite at the Lafayette Medical Center, 2700 Lafayette St. The new office space was donated by St. Joseph Hospital, a member of the Lutheran Health Network. The alliance will share the suite with staff of the Dr. Jeff Towles Health Disparity Initiative.

The alliance will use the space as the new location of its programs, including its prevention clinic; its resource center that provides information and assistance about chronic diseases; support groups for bereavement, cancer patients, cancer survivors and caregivers; and other ethnically appropriate programs related to cancer prevention and early detection.
